- b). A jacket or coat with the inscription “SCCSA Life Member” monogrammed onto the jacket is to be presented to all “Life Members”.
- c). A badge acknowledging their life membership is to be presented to all “Life Members”.
- d). A copy of the “Life Members Register” is to be presented to all “Life Members”.

3. SCCSA RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE “LIFE MEMBER”

- a). All “Life Members” should be invited to all SCCSA formal functions.
- b). All “Life Members” should be invited to Grand Final days.
- c). All “Life Members” should be welcome to COC and AGM meetings.
- d). The membership classification “Life Membership”, does not carry any voting rights.
- e). SCCSA will acknowledge all “Life Members” on an honour board displayed at an SCCSA venue as decided by the Executive of SCCSA.
- f). The secretary of SCCSA will suppress all personal information from the public and associate members of SCCSA.
