Six-a-Side Refund Policy

When a player completes their registration, they agree to this policy and all it contains. Details are frequently updated on the Clubs Facebook page – if players have any further queries they should contact SCCSA Admin (admin@sccsa.org.au) before registering.

Junior players register to Sunshine Coast Churches Soccer Association (SCCSA) while senior players register to Sunshine Coast Churches Football (SCCF). Should a player change their mind after registering to play with either body, there will be no FULL refund of fees. If a request for refund is granted, the amount returned to the player will be the amount paid, less transaction fees incurred during registration.

SCCSA/SCCF understand that circumstances may change for families - any requests for refund should be submitted by email to: admin@sccsa.org.au

- 1. Where a player has registered but is found to have no place in a team, 100% refund will be applied, less transaction fees incurred during registration by the player.
- 2. Where the player is registered but subsequently withdraws their registration before playing a game, 100% refund will be applied, less transaction fees incurred during registration by the player.
- 3. If the player has participated in any form of training session (pre-season or in season), pre-season matches, practice matches, official fixtures, or otherwise appeared on a match record for his or her club, no refund will be given.
- 4. Where a player is registered but is in breach of SCCSA Code of Conduct, and membership is subsequently terminated at any time after registration, no refund will be given.
- 5. Where more than 60% competition is not played due to weather or other adverse condition, player refunds will consist of 60% of the player registration fee received by SCCSA/SCCF (i.e. the amount paid by the player, less transaction fees incurred during registration).
- 6. Where a player is registered and withdraws membership due to a parent or guardian being in breach of SCCSA Code of Conduct, no refund will be given.
- 7. Should a player be unable to play due to circumstances such as injury or any another situation which renders them unable to play for the remainder of the season, SCCSA/SCCF will assess the request for refund to apply a pro-rata refund amount of the fee received by SCCSA/SCCF, according to the amount of games played. Any refund claim due to player injury must be accompanied by a medical certificate.
